# Ensure transparency and accountability in the use of natural resource: 13 recommendations from TIB

"Corruption in land and water management is increasing and people are deprived of their rights. Syndicate of powerful person, public officials and politician are engaged in grabbing state owned land and rivers. Affect of climate change is visible in the country. Natural calamities like flood, storm, and drought increased enormously," said Dr. Iftekharuzzaman, Executive Director of TIB.

Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB)A human chain in front of the Jatya Press club followed by a press conference apart of the

observance of Global Earth Day entitled 'Ensure transparency and accountability in the use of land, water and sustain biodiversity and protect life and living' on 24 September. TIB put 13 recommendations through the press conference to establish transparency and accountability in managing all natural resources.



# Mass participation is required to effective implementation of RTI

The Right to Information (RTI) forum unfolded a report on the implementation of RTI Act, which says 90% people received information who applied to know though RTI. On the other hand 84.3% people who delivered information don't know about the Act and 84.1% thinks lack of proper outreach activity is the only reason for such situation. RTI forum rendered five suggestions to facilitate the law for mass people.

- 1. Information Ready
- 2. Infrastructure of exchanging information
- 3. Mass awareness and demand creation on information
- 4. Application of RTI Act
- 5. Alternative way of information Collection

integrated way will decline corruption of the country." Establishment of more transparency and accountability will ensure more development of the country, said Abul Kalam Azad, Information Minister as Chief guest in a roundtable meeting on September 28 marking the Right to Know Day.

Dr. Iftekharuzzaman, Executive Director TIB said from the human chain "Effective RTI will increase accountability and transparency in private and public sector establishing corruption free good governance the country," Marking the value of National Broadcasting Policy he added "The government should be careful in formulating the national broadcasting policy so that no collusion happens between the policy and the RTI and constitution."
