Transparency International congratulates Prof Yunus

Transparency International (TI) and a number of its chapters worldwide have sent message of congratulations to the Nobel Peace Laureate Prof Muhammad Yunus.

In a message to TI Bangladesh Dr Peter Eigen the Founder of TI and chairman of TI Advisory Council said, "I want to congratulate you and Noble Prize winner Prof. M. Yunus for this wonderful and well deserved honour. We feel elated that the fight against poverty has been recognized as an essential way to build peace.
